Activities follow a planned curriculum and allow children to reinforce and apply what they've learned in the classroom through activities, games, projects and guests. There is time for friends, homework, snacks and physical activity. **Two day minimum per week.**

Additional care is typically available on those days that classes are not held. Save all tuition receipts for tax purposes, as a financial statement will not be provided.
