The Bank of Kentucky is proud to offer the **Minibank** program at St. Joseph School this year. We feel that this program is a great way to teach children the importance and responsibility of saving for the future, while at the same time, gain experience of doing their own banking.

We encourage the students to come up with their own reasons for saving money, whether it is for a Christmas gift, a new bike, their own car, or college tuition. Formulating their own ideas gives them the incentive to save.

Students may open an account at the **Minibank** upon presentation of a completed and signed permission slip. I have attached a permission slip for your convenience. Additional permission slips will be available at the school office, **Minibank**, or the Crescent Springs office of the Bank of Kentucky.

Students that already have a savings account with the Bank of Kentucky may still use the same account number.

The Minibank will be open the first and third Tuesday mornings of each month from 7:00am to 7:20am, beginning November 3, 2008. I will be doing the Half-Day Kindergarten class at 9:25. When the **Minibank** closes for the day, deposits are taken to the Crescent Springs Branch and credited to each student's account. Every student participating in the Minibank program will receive a quarterly statement, reflecting his or her balance and interest that has been paid. The **Minibank** accounts will not be service charged.
